

Eligible Professional Pre-Registration Check-List

- Is my provider type eligible to enroll in the Hawaii Medicaid Promoting Interoperability (PI) Program?
 - Certified Nurse-Midwife Dentist
 - Doctor of Medicine (MD) Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine (DO)
 - Optometrist Pediatrician (MD or DO)
 - Physician Assistant in FQHC/RHC so-led by a PA Registered Nurse Practitioners
- Am I registered as a Hawaii Medicaid Provider with Med-QUEST?
- Is my National Provider Identifier (NPI) on file with Med-QUEST?
- Is my Social Security Number (SSN) on file with Med-QUEST?
- Was my Medicaid enrollment status “Active” during my chosen 90-day eligibility period?
- Is my license on file with the Med-QUEST Division (MQD) and was it active during my chosen 90-day eligibility period?

I am assigning my EHR payment to myself.

- Is my payee Tax Identification Number (TIN) linked to one of my active payment address records?

I am assigning my EHR payment to another provider (payee).

- Is the provider that I am assigning payment to registered as an active Hawaii Medicaid Provider with MQD?
- Is the payee NPI on file with MQD?
- Is the payee TIN linked to one of the payment address records of the provider I am assigning payment to?
- Is the payee TIN linked to one of my payment address records? (This ensures a business relationship between attesting provider and payee for 1099 assignment.)
